Board Certification as a psychiatrist, current professional license in discipline, minimum of 5 years of experience working in various components of a hospital and health care system, 3 years of direct clinical experience and 2 years in management, and knowledge of the Joint Commission accreditation process. You must also be able to lift 25 lbs., climb stairs and ladders, work in setting with infectious diseases, and travel nationwide 100percent of work time. Relocation is not required. Fluency in Spanish a plus. Part time positions require two weeks or three weeks per months of availability and intermittent requires one consecutive week of availability.
